She came to the Verde Valley as a child with her family from Missouri by covered wagon in 1875.

Born Sept 17, 1862, IA

Died July 3, 1926, Camp Verde, AZ

Daughter of [Samuel Cotton Dickinson](#) and [Nancy Jane Green Dickinson](#).

Married to William Berryman Back on December 23, 1878.

Marjorie and her husband purchased Montezuma Well ranch for the price of two horses.
(Montezuma Well National Monument)

Marjorie was the oldest daughter of Samuel Cotton Dickinson who arrived August 23, 1875 at Middle Verde with his wife and family in a wagon train from Humansville, Missouri. Other families that were part of the 1875 wagon train included the Humans, Burfords, Bristows, Davidsons, Letts, Hawkins, and Hutchinsons.
