



Nancy Jane Green Dickinson

August 23, 1875, arrives on Beaver Creek at the Wales Arnold Ranch near Montezuma Well

Born: Reading, OH April 22, 1836

Died: Long Beach, CA November 7, 1916

Burial: Cottonwood Cemetery, Cottonwood, Arizona (Plot C/437)

Parents: Samuel Green (? -1888) and Caroline Green (1817-1887)

Spouse: Samuel Cotton Dickinson

Nancy married Samuel in Van Buren County, Iowa, on June 2, 1860.

April 26, 1875: left Missouri to join a wagon train heading to Arizona.

August 23, 1875: arrives on Beaver Creek at the Wales Arnold Ranch.

After 1876: the family changed their name from Dickerson to Dickinson

Because Samuel and Caroline (Smith) Green are the parents of Nancy Jane (Green)

Dickerson/Dickinson, she may be related to Luranda (Smith) Bristow, the wife of "Parson" James Bristow.
